FACTS Program: Payments are electronically made through FACTS Management (<https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/42673> link at stbartsschool.net) via a checking account or credit card. Enrollment is mandatory. Families are able to pay their tuition in one of 3 ways:

1. *Payment-in-full due in May - \$10 enrollment fee and \$250 discount*
2. *11-month plan beginning in May, 2nd tuition payment in July - \$45 enrollment fee*
3. *10-month plan beginning in May, 2nd tuition payment in August - \$45 enrollment fee*

The annual enrollment fee will be automatically processed within 14 days of the agreement being posted. Any changes to payment dates must be submitted in writing via e-mail to gybarra@stbartholomew.net **at least 2 business days prior** to the scheduled payment date. The first payment is due May 10. The Instructional Materials/Technology/Books Fee is due in July also through FACTS. Tuition payments will be processed monthly on or around the 10th during the school year through April.

FUNDRAISING: Each family earns \$275 goal in percentage credits from March 1, 2022-February 28, 2023 or may issue a direct payment of \$275. If no fundraising is planned, a partial payment of \$100 is expected by November, 2022. The balance of the fundraising fee will be billed through FACTS for final payment in March.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT: In addition to the fundraising obligation, each family will be required to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours. Volunteers **MUST** be Virtus-trained in order to volunteer when children are present (school events, field trips, etc.). If volunteer hours are not fulfilled, an additional \$50 will be added to their fundraising obligation.

FINANCIAL AID: Through the “Invest in Kids Act,” Illinois low-income families will have access to a Tax Credit Scholarship (TCS). Families that qualify can apply for scholarships beginning January 2022. More information is available on the school website stbartsschool.net. If families do not qualify for a TCS, we have additional scholarships available through the Facts Grant & Aid Application. The application opens in February.
